EPUB Preferred on Ebook Central | Coming January 2025

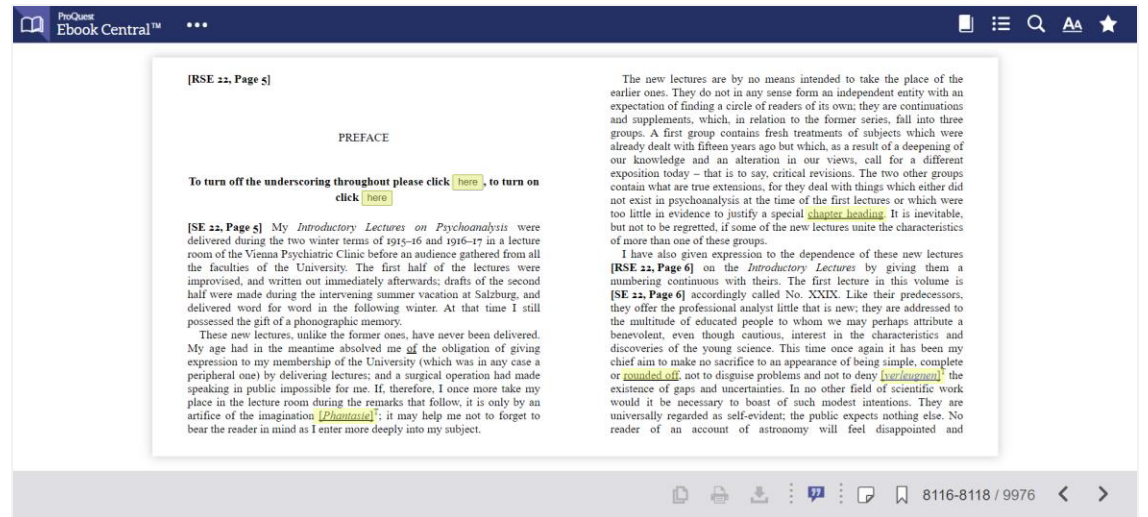
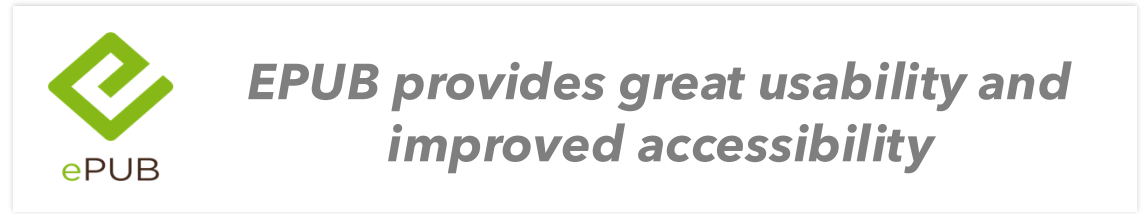
We are making changes in support of the European Accessibility Act 2025 and Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act

'EPUB Preferred' – On **January 23, 2025**, we will switch the default online reading format on Ebook Central from PDF to EPUB. This change will make reading easier and more accessible, especially for screen reader users, without needing to turn on Text-Only mode.

Why Electronic Publications (EPUBs)?

- EPUB is quickly becoming the industry **standard ebook format**.
- EPUBs provide users with *'reflowable text'* and **optimal reading experience** across devices.
- EPUBs often include embedded features and links **for easy navigation** between sections, the index, and external resources.
- EPUBs' **structured markup** enables effective use of text-to-speech and screen readers for improved accessibility.

What this means for your users: Most users won't see any changes to their reading experience. However, those using instructional materials with specific page number references might notice differences across devices because EPUB adjusts to screen size (reflowable), unlike PDF's fixed layout.

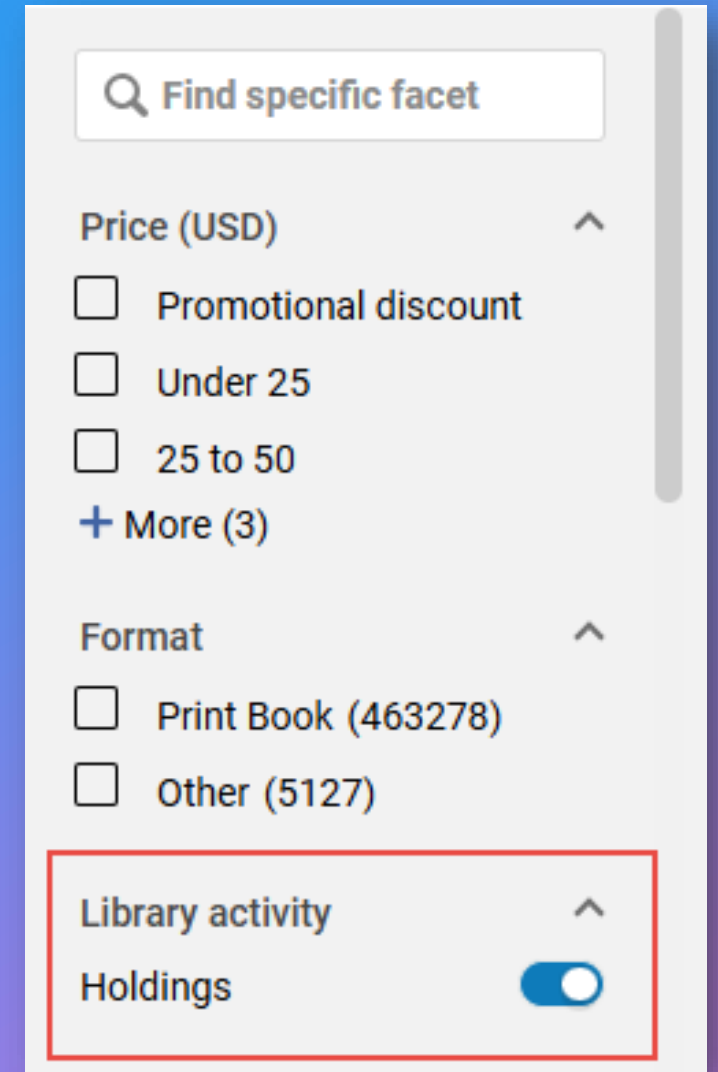
New "Subject" Field in the Query Builder and Facet

- The Query Builder search functionality has been enhanced to allow users to refine searches by normalized subject values.
- The new "Subject" field is comparable to the same field in LibCentral. A "Subject" facet has also been added to search results filters.
- Eliminates the need to navigate through specific LCC and DDC trees to find books under broad categories.



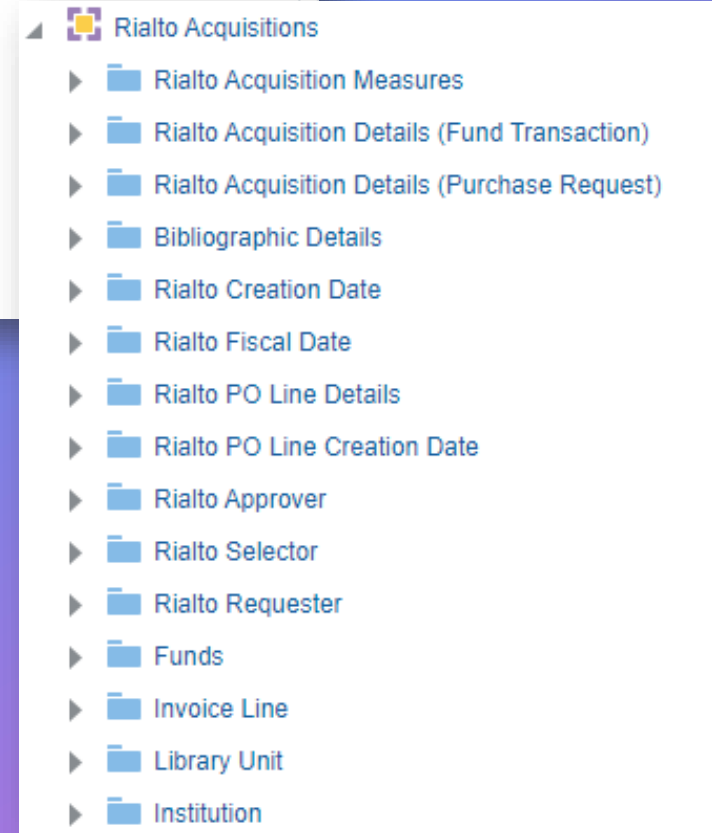
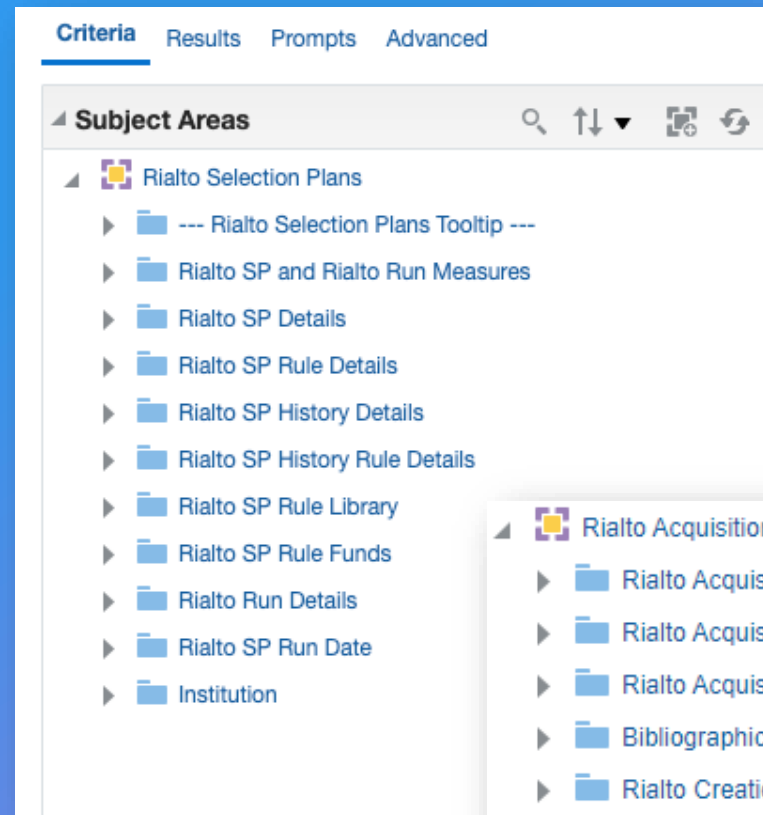
Library Activity Facet with Holdings Toggle

- To enhance search precision, we've added a "Holdings" toggle under the new Library Activity facet, enabling users to include or exclude their institution's holdings in search results.
- This toggle is available across all Rialto pages where book metadata facets are available.
- When enabled (the default setting), it includes all types of holdings (DDA, EBA, owned, and subscribed) within search results. When set to exclude, titles with institutional holdings are removed from display.



Rialto Subject Areas in Analytics

- **Rialto Acquisitions** and **Rialto Selection Plans** have been added as subject areas in Alma Analytics.
- Helps users generate reports for Rialto purchases or refine existing reports with greater ease, without needing to perform exports of Rialto page data and maintain spreadsheets.
- The Rialto Selection Plans Subject Area can be used to make reports about Rialto Selection Plan purchases and activity.
- The Rialto Acquisitions Subject Area includes relevant dimensions from other subject areas such as purchase request, fund, physical and e inventory, and invoice. All data is pre-filtered to Rialto, to allow for easier report generation.
