




Date filtering quick links added to medical databases

The UK NHS told us that book and other content older than 10 years is routinely removed from libraries that serve clinical settings and asked about our curation policies.

We explained that such content still has value for our academic customers and offered a more prominent way of removing older content from search results as a way to meet their need.

My Research: sort by name

This is another PEP update after an NHS request ([PPC-175](#)).

Currently, saved searches are presented in the order in which they were saved, with no ability to change this.

We already provide the ability to name a search, and users are more likely to recall that name than the order in which they saved searches.

So the saved searches page has been reformatted to a table, so as to allow sorting on either name or date, via clicking on arrows within the column headers, a common and naturally intuitive means of sorting information.

Very high clickthrough rate and conversion to My Research account creation/login

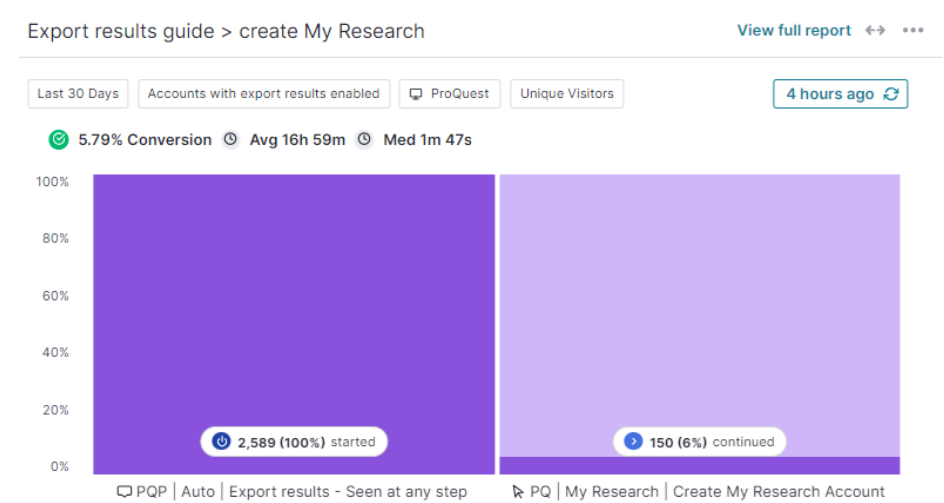
- 25%+ of users sign into My Research after seeing the guide



Support for DOI and direct links to PDF from linking providers

Inbound links to PDF

- Linking vendors have expressed the desire to link to PQ PDFs directly, describing it as a barrier to user satisfaction with the service they provide.
- Currently, PQP lands the user on the 'best available format', which is the HTML version of the full text where it is present, even if there is *also* a PDF. This will not change for users already on PQP because of the superior user experience HTML full text offers around accessibility, hit-highlighting, copy/paste, device responsiveness and more.
- But we have added support to the inbound OpenURL service for a new parameter that specifically requests a PDF - [&ftformat=pdf](#)
- Where the linking vendor chooses to send us the parameter, we will land the user on the PDF version of the full text, if present. If we have no PDF for the document, we will do as today and land them on the best available full text format that we have for the document.

Inbound links to DOI

- Since the development of the OpenURL standard, the DOI (Digital Object Identifier) has become a widespread and reliable way to uniquely identify a document.
- Where linking vendors send us inbound links containing a DOI, we will use it to locate the record. Where there is no match, we will still fall back on a search for any other metadata they include in the link (journal title, issn, date, page, title and so on).

Climate change and air pollution are closely linked; climate change is caused by air pollution, and climate change makes air pollution worse. Air pollution from human society is the key factor currently driving climate change. As it is a significant existential threat to society, climate change is not only the subject of intense scientific research, but it is also an important ethical issue. Ethics, and in particular environmental ethics, is an important tool to analyze the ethical implications and moral acceptability of human actions. Despite the mounting evidence of the causes of climate change, environmental pollution, and their effects, action to tackle these issues has been nominal, slowed down by myopic economic factors that dominate the discussions surrounding climate and environmental policy. It is clear to many that the economy is a subset of society that can only operate within the context of the biosphere and that in addition to threatening human well-being and health, climate change threatens global ecosystem functioning as we know it.

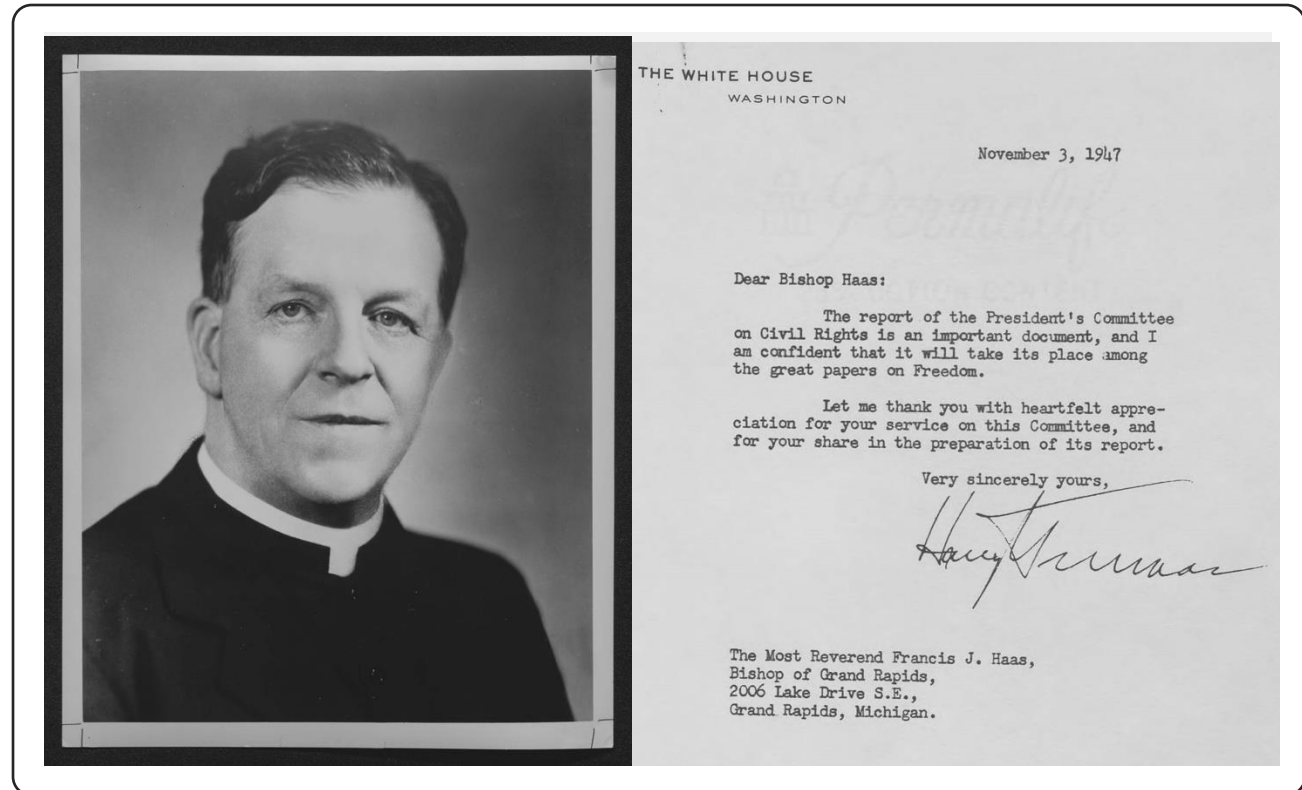
