#### 4. Enhancements/Issues raised by Sherif members

- The Google sign in option is problematic for some; particularly due to library staff being unable to carry out user password resets. This adds to a wider concern about using 3<sup>rd</sup> party sign in.
- EDS administrators can no longer reset any user passwords, whereas previously this was possible for username/password accounts. This functionality had been useful to respond quickly to students (SC)
- Issues with exporting results to 3<sup>rd</sup> parties such as Endnote were reported; including insufficient export limits and error alerts appearing to be more frequent.
- KH noted feedback regarding recent Publication Finder outage and will share with EBSCO.
- Information was shared about Health Research Premium Collection – UK Academic edition being available in EDS, in place of the existing package (SC). This incorporates geo-restrictions applicable to the UK market.
- Issue with EBSCO admin passwords requiring more frequent reset. KH will raise this with EBSCO.
- Concern about records in EDS not being updated to pick up changes to URLs. KH will raise this with EBSCO.
- Some colleagues reported switching off their integration with EBSCO subscription agent due to activation inaccuracies (non-subscribed content activated in error and requiring manual deactivation in EDS).
- Some functionality is missing from the new EDS interface. Subject librarians require Boolean search functionality and are therefore reluctant to switch from the old interface until it becomes available. There is no patron integration. KH to follow up for next meeting

#### 5. November Meeting Planning

Discovery/linking enhancements (PR). PR has done some work on search precision, with the aim of finding an objective measure to assess the accuracy of providers' metadata and custom linking in EDS. PR will create a summary and ask for feedback from other users by email, using the EBSCO Partners and Sherif Users lists.

#### 6. Enhancement Communications

Discussion of whether to survey Sherif members to ask how they would like notification of EBSCO enhancements to be communicated to them.
